# Public Health Education Program

One of our emerging programs in support of SILAMP mission:

Public Health Education Program

Our Public Health Education Program (PHEdP) seeks to educate and support our Latinx Community during the COVID-19 pandemic. The Latinx and Hispanic population in the Greater Philadelphia Region counts for almost 500,000 million according to a study lead by the Greater Philadelphia Hispanic Chamber of Commerce. SILAMP has organized a campaign to fill the gaps in the lack of education on the prevention, treatment, and management of the COVID-19 among Spanish speaking communities. Through our PHEdP, we developed emergency outreach and education content material in collaboration with our professional resources and partnered with organizations also serving the Latinx communities. Through the PHEdP produced over 29 community educational videos thus far. The chosen methods are via videos, interviews, and written media to distribute to the population through our digital presence in the traditional media, social media, and website. Our multi-disciplinary group of professionals currently serves by providing their evidence-based advice from experts on the field and following official authorities guidelines framed on the COVID-19 within their scope of practice.

Younger partners support our mission by working collaboratively targeting the youth and young adult population on related topics for the Spanish speaking communities in our region.
